To Ukraine, why?

This is a question that people often ask participants at the camps and at Working Hands. One of the participants says the following:

Camp experience

What are you going to do in Ukraine? How was your camp? You can expect those questions from someone who wants to sponsor or has sponsored the camps. I have been along a few times and so I have been asked those questions as well. The first time, I would have said something like: we are going to hold children's camps for underprivileged children and show them something of what the Lord Jesus means to us. But when you get back, what will you say then? I say something like: I went to bring something, but I received much more

than I brought. You can tell them that, but you can't convey that feeling. You must have experienced it. An experience you will never forget. And you know what? The children at the camps think so too! Beautiful, isn't it?

So far this participant! You can also gain this experience by joining Camp Ukraine or Working Hands! Come to the first preparation evening for Camp Ukraine 2022 on Tuesday 18 January.

Camp Ukraine 2022

This year the departure for Camp Ukraine is planned on Monday 25 July. The first day we have a long drive of about 1,300 km. We will travel with vans. In these vans we also take a lot of camp stuff with us. The journey itself is an experience! We stay overnight in Hungary. The following day, we drive 500 km including the border crossing between Hungary and Ukraine. Always a bit exciting. Then it's off to the camp sites which are about 30 to 70 km from the border. On Monday 8 August, after a wonderful camp, we will return home again. We will spend the night in Southern Germany and arrive back in Rijnsburg in life and well-being Tuesday evening 9 August at 19.30 hrs.



On the route to Ukraine the participants from Rouveen and surroundings will be met near the Dutch - German border at AC Zevenaar. On the way back we will say goodbye to them there as well. We are eagerly looking forward to getting on the road!
